

## RWANDA SINGLE ORIGIN ROBUSTA

SEMI-WASHED

Rwanda is a landlocked East African country with a green, mountainous landscape. Its renowned Volcanoes National Park is home to mountain gorillas and golden monkeys. The park encompasses 4,507 m tall Mt. Karisimbi and 4 other forested volcanoes. In the southwest is Nyungwe National Park, with ancient mountain rain-forest that's a habitat for chimpanzees and other primates. Rwanda borders Uganda to the north, Democratic Republic of the Congo to the west, Burundi to the south and Tanzania to the east.

Our Rwandan Robusta is from an Award-Winning single plantation. This coffee is grown at an elevation of 1600 m in the southern province which includes the eastern edge of the Nyungwe Forest, home to many Chimpanzees. The coffee coffee is bold with a smooth finish and has several middle notes. The cup is all about bittering cocoa, mild malty sweetness, muted acidity, and massive body. Roasted buckwheat, and nutty notes mark the aroma and finish.
